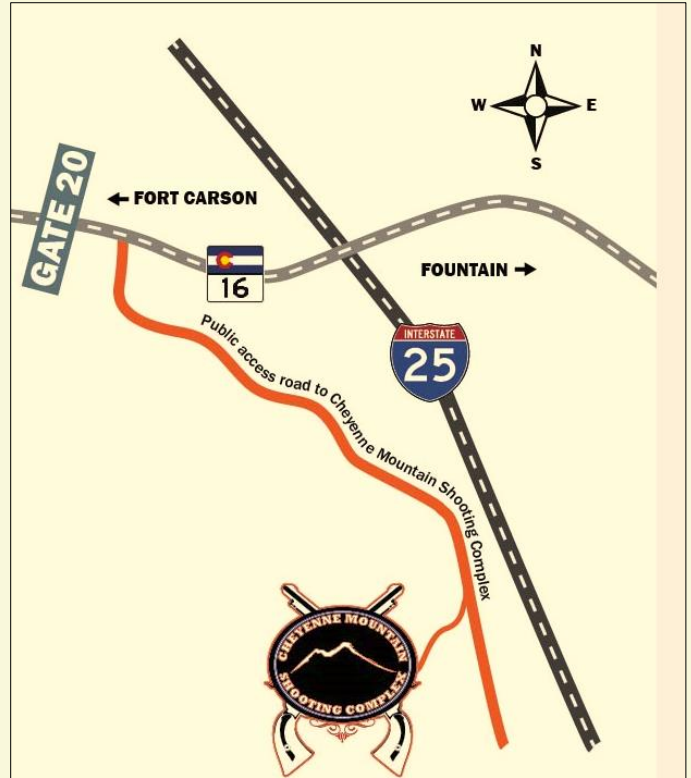
Participants will meet at 8 am, Thursday, Aug 22 in the lobby of the Hotel Eleganté Grand Ballroom for a travel brief and then depart at 8:30 am. Registration fee is \$6 (normally \$9) and shotgun rental is \$10. There are both 12ga and 20ga shotguns available to rent, and they may be shared. Ammunition is \$7 for a box of 25 shells. There are two ranges available. "You can't beat the price!"

Pullers and scorers are pulled from the shooters. **Hearing and eye protection are required to be on the range, there are NO EXCEPTIONS to this!**

2019 Pikes Peak Highway Tour

Tour Length: 4 Hours **Departure Times: 8:00 am, 9:00am, 1:00 pm, or 2:00 pm**
Group Rates: \$55.00 for Adults. 20 person minimum.

Includes Complimentary transportation, tour and Pikes Peak Highway toll.

If you can only choose one tour in the Colorado Springs area, the Pikes Peak Tour is the one to take! This spectacular 14,115 foot peak, offers today's visitors "*a purple mountain's majesty*," for it was of this magnificent mountain that Katherine Lee Bates wrote "American the Beautiful". This tour's route travels up historic Ute Pass through the village of Cascade to the Pikes Peak Highway. As the road climbs higher, each new curve offers yet another spectacular mountain vista and you'll see mountains, dense forests and tundra, a fragile and desolate ecosystem in which on footstep off the path can take years for Mother Nature to repair. At the summit, you'll feel like you're on top of the world, and the views stretch for miles. To the south, the Arkansas Valley, the Gold Rush town of Cripple Creek and the often-snowcapped Sangre de Cristo Mountain Range seem close enough to touch. To the west lies the Continental Divide; eastward "*amber waves of grain*" roll on farther than you can see; while the north shows the distant skyline of Denver and beyond that, the peaks of Rocky Mountain National Park.

During the 60-mile roundtrip, we will take several rest stops so you can slowly acclimate to altitude changes, stretch your legs and take pictures. **Be sure to bring a jacket** – or why not purchase your souvenir sweatshirt, hat, or bottle water prior to departure. **Those on oxygen should consider bringing extra for Pikes Peak Highway Tours or White Water Rafting due to altitude or length of tour.**

2019 Royal Gorge Bridge & Prison Tour

The Royal Gorge Bridge – home to America’s highest suspension bridge and Zip Line!! The views alone will take your breath away, as will a gondola ride across the gorge. You will have time to explore and have lunch before we take off for our Prison Tour. We will first go to the Prison Museum in Canon City. This building was once the States’ Women’s Facility and has many stories. From there we will drive by the Super Max Prison in Florence. This is home to worst of the worst and is known as the “Alcatraz of the Rockies”. It is designed to hold 490 inmates but to date has never been filled. We will take that as a good thing!! Enjoy your tour of the Southwest!!

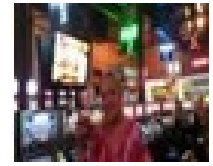
